**RE: Municipal Solid Waste Proposal**

Dear Mayor Hamm,

Area Disposal Service, Inc., a GFL Environmental subsidiary, is proud to present this proposal for a solid waste contract with the City of Marquette Heights. In exchange for a five-year exclusive residential contract, GFL will provide a comprehensive solid waste program. The starting fee will be **\$18.75** per unit per month. The contract will provide the following elements:

- **TRASH** Weekly curbside trash collection for residential households in a GFL issued 95-gallon trash cart. Weekly trash volume limited to the cart plus two (2) private cans or bags or the GFL issued cart and an additional private cart compatible with GFL's automated tipping equipment. Each private can/bag is limited to 35-gallons and 50 pounds. There is no volume limit on properly contained trash during the two weeks following Christmas. A second GFL trash cart is an additional \$7.00 per month to rent. GFL will collect Christmas trees annually during the last collection in December through the last collection day in January. Trees more than five-feet in length must be cut in half.
- **RECYCLING** Every other week curbside recycling collection in a GFL issued 95-gallon recycling cart. All recycling material is limited to what fits in the cart. Households must opt-in to the recycling program to participate. A second recycling cart is an additional \$7.00 per month to rent.
- **BULKY -ITEM CLEANUP** Households can dispose of "bulky-items" at the curb such as a mattresses, old furniture, and small amounts of construction debris during a mutually agreed upon community cleanup date annually. Volume is limited to 5 cubic yards of material per household. In addition to the annual curbside cleanup, GFL will collect "bulky-items" for \$35.00 per item throughout the year. Residents will need to call ahead to arrange for a special pickup and pay in advance.
- **CITY PROPERTIES/FESTIVAL** All City owned properties receive free weekly commercial trash service with GFL commercial dumpsters and every other week recycling services. City sponsored community events or festivals will receive free services.
- **ELECTRONIC WASTE** All City residents in good standing under the contract get access to our electronic waste drop-off center at 1090 W. Jefferson St, Morton. Limit two (2) televisions annually. Kuusakoski Recycling processes the electronic waste collected at the Morton facility. *This e-waste drop-off service is only available as long as Kuusakoski Recycling remains open for business in Peoria, IL.*



Under this proposal, GFL would collect the monthly fee for residential services quarterly in advance from each household for approximately 1,100 addresses.

The monthly fee to start the contract is **\$18.75** per unit per month with fixed annual 4% increases. The fee structure follows this table:

If the City was to take over the fee collection on the water bill and pay GFL monthly in arrears, the City would **retain \$1.25** per unit of the monthly fee structure. To work in concert with this exclusive franchise agreement, the City would also need an ordinance requiring all households to have residential solid waste services with the Village's designated contractor.

The agreement between GFL and the City would also contain language allowing for a two-year renewal period under same or different terms. Let me know if you have any questions regarding this proposal.

### PROPOSAL FOR CURBSIDE SERVICES

Mayor Hamm and the City Council,

Waste Management of Illinois, Inc. (WM) appreciated this opportunity to propose continued solid waste collection and disposal services for the city and citizens of Marquette Heights. Waste Management has been fortunate to provide subscription service within the city for decades, and we appreciate this opportunity to propose professional curbside environmental services for the City and citizens.

I can certify to you and the Council that WM has fully reviewed the scope of services provided in the request for proposals and based on those specifications we are offering the City the following scope of services:

#### **SOLID WASTE (GARBAGE) COLLECTION**

WM will provide weekly collection of accumulated residential solid waste to all residential units. Each residential unit will be provided a 96-gallon capacity wheeled cart for the storage and collection of solid waste. Collection will be limited to the contents of the wheeled cart.

Additional 96-gallon carts will be available for rental at a rate of \$ 2.00 per month per cart.

#### **RECYCLING COLLECTION**

WM proposes to provide scheduled curbside collection of accumulated recyclable commodities from all residential units within the City on an Every Other Week schedule.

All listed recyclable commodities including glass containers listed in the attached recycling handout will be included in the curbside recycling program. Each residential unit will receive an instructional mailing detailing the schedule of collections and accepted commodities for collection.

Every Other Week Collection is rapidly becoming the standard for recyclable collection, largely due to the constantly increasing costs of fuel, labor and transportation equipment, Every Other Week collection allows continued service at lower costs while decreasing truck traffic within the City, reducing street surface wear and eliminating over 27,000# of carbon emissions annually.

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### ANNUAL CLEAN UP DAY

WM will provide the City with an annual curbside clean up event with each residential unit provided one collection during the event. The restrictions listed in the application will apply.

### CITY PROPERTIES AND COMMERCIAL SERVICES

WM will provide commercial containers and weekly service to City owned facilities. Additionally, Waste Management will provide roll off special event service for two events per year as part of the proposed service agreement. Special event services will be provided at no additional charge.


### COMPENSATION RATES

WM proposes to provide the City and citizens of Marquette Heights with weekly solid waste service including a cart for each residential unit, every other week recycling collection including a cart for each residential unit, a curbside clean up day collection service annually and service at City and related facilities weekly.

Compensation rate for this service option set at \$27.42 per unit per month in the first year of the agreement billed individually to subscribing residents. Compensation rates would increase by a factor of 5% per year on the anniversary date of the agreement.

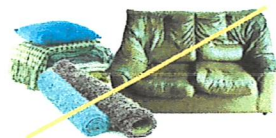

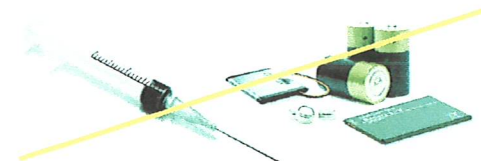
